The event begins **promptly at 6:30 pm** with a performance by Mr. Ellis' Grade 6 choir. There will be a light carvery station paired with Mediterranean appetizers and a cash bar. The Silent Auction will close **PROMPTLY at 8:30 pm**. All items must be paid for (credit cards and cheques accepted) and removed the night of the event.
